

## Rural Transport

### What you need to know

- There are 18 Rural Community Transport Partnerships in Northern Ireland
- Partnership offer services to people who have no access to other forms of transport
- Partnerships may offer services for groups or individuals or both
- You need to be a member to use services
- All Partnerships have transport accessible to disabled people including wheelchair users
- Services are accessible to older people
- Drivers have received training in assisting disabled people and older people
- Drivers will help you to get on and off transport
- You must live in rural area to use services

### Things to think about

- Check what is available in your area
- Check if the services are suitable for you
- Your local Partnership may also know of other transport available in your area
